



Dr. Bradley Bakotic Named Keynote Speaker at the NYCPM Commencement

ALPHARETTA, GA - May 9, 2018 – At the Commencement for the Class of 2018, on May 24 at Alice Tully Hall at Lincoln Center, **Bradley W. Bakotic, DPM, DO** will deliver the keynote address and receive an honorary Doctor of Science degree, Honoris Causa.

Dr. Bakotic is a dermatopathologist who founded the Rhett Foundation for the Advancement of Podiatric Medical Education with his career-long business partner Joseph “Jody” Hackle, MD.

NYCPM received the foundation’s first gift, an unrestricted grant, in October, and has just received a second grant.



Dr. Bakotic earned his Master of Biomedical Sciences and Doctorate of Podiatric Medicine from Barry University between 1988 and 1992. He graduated cum laude from the University of New England College of Osteopathic Medicine and completed fellowship training in oncologic surgical pathology at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center (MSKCC) and in dermatopathology at the Ackerman Academy at Columbia University.

The Rhett Foundation was founded in 2017 by Bradley Bakotic DO, DPM and Jody Hackel, MD for the Advancement of Podiatric Medical Education and as a means to give back to the underserved world of lower extremity dermatology education.
